The deliveries in July were on a continued low level and the total deliveries were down by 65% compared with the year-earlier period. The deliveries to the European markets decreased by 72% and in North America the deliveries decreased by 65%.

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Mack

Mack deliveries in July totaled 899 vehicles, down 25% compared with the year-earlier period. Prevailing economic conditions continue to weigh heavily on the North American market for heavy trucks. Mack has been impacted by particularly low industry-wide truck sales in two of its core market segments, construction and local hauling, due to the dramatic decline in housing construction and ongoing weakness in consumer retail sales.

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Renault Trucks

The deliveries from Renault Trucks in July decreased with 56% compared with the year-earlier period. Eastern Europe saw the biggest decline and deliveries fell by 94%. On the European market as a whole, the market for medium duty distribution trucks fared somewhat better compared to other segments.

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Nissan Diesel

Deliveries from Nissan Diesel in July totaled 1,781 units, which was a decrease by 57% compared to the year-earlier period. In Japan, the number of deliveries was 963 units, a decrease by 49%. The Japanese government's stimulus programs have started to have some effect on the demand. The Middle East market saw the biggest decrease and the deliveries fell by 90%.
