Truck deliveries in July 2010

Total deliveries from the Volvo Group's truck operations in July amounted to 14,377 vehicles. This was an increase of 62% compared with the year-earlier period.

Volvo Trucks

Globally, deliveries in July were 116% higher than in the corresponding month last year. Demand for new trucks continues to increase in several markets.

Demand in South America remains strong and deliveries rose to 1,489 trucks in July, an increase of 149% compared with July 2009.

In Europe, demand is gradually recovering, particularly in Northern and Central Europe. During the first seven months of the year, 14,462 trucks were delivered, an increase of 18%. This can be compared with July, when the increase in Europe was 80%.

In North America, deliveries also increased 39% during the year and by a full 149% in July. The rise is largely due to increased demand for long-distance trucks and the fact that the new trucks equipped with new engines in accordance with US10 were well received by customers.

Mack

Mack's deliveries in July totaled 758 vehicles, down 16% compared with the year-earlier period.

As large competitor inventories of pre-US10 engines appear to have finally been drawn down, customer response to, and interest in, the US10 trucks being offered by Mack and Volvo Trucks North America has been steadily building. Overall demand has been improving, with customer activity in highway offsetting continued weakness in construction related segments.

Renault Trucks

Deliveries from Renault Trucks in July increased by 39% compared with the year-earlier period.

The increase is attributable to upswings for heavy and medium-heavy trucks. Deliveries of light trucks were lower, since the new generation of Renault Master is set to be delivered successively during the autumn of 2010.

UD Trucks

Deliveries from UD Trucks in July totaled 2,656 units, which was an increase of 49% compared with the year-earlier period. Demand in Japan is currently slowing down, from a period of stimulus of scrapping incentives and pre-buy ahead of new emission legislation.

In South East Asia, the number of deliveries was 653 units, increased by 189%, driven by a robust demand in Indonesia from the mining industry.
