Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations 2009

In accordance with the Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations 2009, Volvo Group UK Limited has registered with the UK Environment Agency as a producer of industrial and automotive batteries and as a small producer of portable batteries, reference **BPRN00287**. Volvo Group UK Limited is also a distributor of all types of batteries.

Producers, importers and distributors of batteries and accumulators have obligations for the collection or take-back, treatment, recycling and disposal of waste batteries and accumulators of the types they supply at the request of their customers and other end users.

Volvo Group UK Limited is the importer and distributor of all Volvo Group products in the UK and variously trades as:

Volvo Group UK Limited provides a free take-back service for waste lithium-ion industrial batteries of a type similar to that placed on the market by Volvo Group UK Limited and this service is available at all Volvo Truck and Bus Centres and Renault Truck Commercials depots.

Volvo Group UK Limited provides a free collection and take-back service for waste automotive batteries and this service is available at all Volvo Truck and Bus Centres and Renault Truck Commercials depots. Automotive batteries are usually lead-acid type and commonly used to provide electrical energy for the starting of automotive engines.

Volvo Group UK Limited provides a free take-back service for portable batteries at parts sales counters at all Volvo Truck and Bus Centres and Renault Truck Commercials depots.
