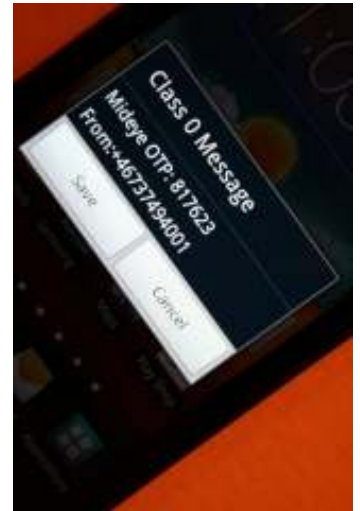


HOW TO USE SMS One-Time Password

for Faros users

The SMS One-Time Password service uses the ordinary mobile phone as a security device to provide strong authentication for remote access to the corporate network. When the end-user requests access to a protected resource, the user is asked to enter their usual userid and password, and an additional one-time password delivered via a managed SMS service to the users' mobile phone. No software installation on the mobile phone is required. The service works with any GSM phone as long as it is connected to a GSM network listed on <http://www.mideye.com/en/support>.



NOTE! SMS One-Time Password service is individually assigned and the holder is personally responsible for its use.

Typical Log In procedure:

1. Start a Connect Service e.g. MyAccess <https://myaccess.volvo.com>
2. Select the *SMS-OTP* authentication realm
3. Enter your *username* and *password*, press "Sign In" and wait for the SMS containing the One-Time Password to pop-up on your mobile phone.
4. Enter the One-Time Password in the *Response* field, press "Sign In"

NOTE! You need to order connect services such as MyAccess separately.

Before you can use SMS One-Time Password, you need to complete the following:

- Order the SMS One-Time Service
- Register your SMS phone number

Order SMS One-Time Password

To be able to use the service, you must first request it from Faros. Observe that you must have access to the Volvo intranet to perform the steps below:

- Access Faros at <http://faros.volvo.com>
- Select *Request Service*, then *Connect Services*
- In the *Search* field enter **SMS** and press "Search"
- Select *SMS One-Time Password* by clicking "Add to cart"
- press "Continue"
- On the next form, press "Continue"

The SMS One-Time Password service is now ordered.

Register SMS phone number

You must also associate your SMS phone number with your user account. Observe that you must have access to the Volvo intranet to perform the steps below:

- Access Faros at <http://faros.volvo.com>
- Select *Self Service*, then *User Information*, then *Update Information*
- Enter your SMS phone number in the *SMS OTP Phone Number* field
- Press "Update"

Your SMS phone number is now registered in Faros. It may take several hours before underlying systems are updated.
