The conversions were implemented with the support of the opportunity for Series A shareholders to request conversion of Series A shares to Series B shares which was entered in the Articles of Association at the 2011 Annual General Meeting.

Today, 31 August 2023, the last trading day of the month, there are a total of 2,033,452,084 registered shares in AB Volvo. Of these are 444,986,702 Series A shares and 1,588,465,382 Series B shares. The number of votes in the company amounts to 603,833,240.2 based on the number of registered shares.
