Transport by Jockey – Handling Guideline

In addition to adhering to the regulatory framework outlined in ECG, the following rules must be strictly observed during jockey transportation:

- 1. Safety Compliance: Always adhere to the safety requirements within the compound or yard.
- 2. **Handover Inspection:** Conduct a thorough handover inspection before departing from the compound or yard.
- 3. **Dashboard Check:** Inspect the vehicle's dashboard for any warning symbols. If a warning is displayed, notify the dispatch center or site security staff immediately.
- 4. **Loose Parts:** Ensure all non-attached parts are securely stowed.
- 5. **Passenger Restrictions:** Transporting passengers is strictly prohibited.
- 6. Smoking Policy: Smoking is prohibited both inside and in close proximity to the truck.
- 7. **Driver's Seat Protection:** Plastic protection for the driver's seat may be removed during driving but must be replaced upon delivery. Do not remove or damage plastic protection for the bed.
- 8. Eating and Drinking: Eating and drinking in the cab are not permitted.
- 9. **Driving Conduct:** Drive with care and adhere to traffic regulations.
- 10. **Brake Distance and Stability:** Note that trucks without superstructure have very low rear axle pressure, affecting brake distance and stability.
- 11. Bogie Axel: If the truck is equipped with a bogie axle, it must be lifted while driving.
- 12. Road Construction: Drive slowly in areas of road construction to avoid chipping.
- 13. **Convoy Driving:** Avoid driving in convoys. If unavoidable, maintain sufficient distance to prevent stone chipping.
- 14. **Mechanical Issues:** In case of mechanical problems during transport, contact Volvo Action Service & Transport Operation.
- 15. **Number Plate:** Ensure the transfer number plate is securely attached without causing damage to the vehicle.
- 16. **Resting Times:** During resting periods, park vehicles in secured sites belonging to the transport company or in guarded parking/service areas.
- 17. Cleanliness: Leave the truck in a clean condition upon delivery.
- 18. **Fuel Policy:** Unless otherwise agreed, jockey suppliers should refill the diesel to the same amount consumed.
- 19. **Professionalism:** Always conduct yourself professionally, remembering you represent Volvo Group.
