New Requirements for All Employees Working on Site at LVO Facilities

Last evening, Wednesday, April 15, 2020, Governor Wolf and the State of Pennsylvania issued new requirements impacting all businesses currently approved to continue operations.

Effective Sunday, April 19, 2020, all employees, contractors and vendors working on site will be required to wear a mask while working at our Lehigh Valley Operations (LVO), Lehigh Valley Logistics Center (LVLC) and Mack Customer Center (MCC) facilities. The only exceptions to wearing a mask while at work will be during breaks and lunch to eat or drink, or employees working in isolation where appropriate social distancing of 6 feet can be maintained at all times. Individuals are permitted to wear their own masks made in accordance with CDC guidance.

We also ask every person to self-check their temperature daily prior to coming on site. If you have a temperature above 100.4° F (38° C), you are not permitted on site. Should you exhibit symptoms, including a fever and / or a persistent cough and respiratory issues throughout the day, please notify your manager and exit the premises.

As a reminder, wearing a mask does not replace the requirement to practice social distancing. We are committed to taking all steps necessary for maintaining a healthy work environment for our employees.
